WHEN DO I NEED EASYPILL RESOLVIN FLEX ?

- Only if symptoms:
 - lameness, difficulty moving
 - Pain at moving

Usable for all cats and kittens that are able to eat solid food

COMPOSITION

- Willow (1.32mg of salicylates* per pellet)
- Fish oil rich in omega-3 (DHA)
- Devil's claw (*Harpagophytum*)
- Glucosamine, chondroitin
- Chelated zinc and manganese
- DL-methionine
- Vitamin E
- EasyPill base



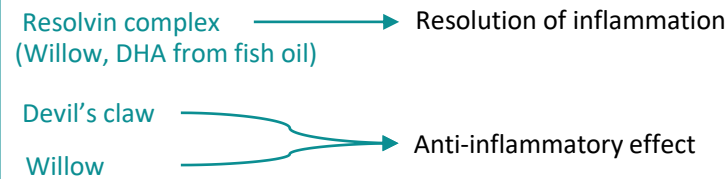
PACKAGING

- Sachet of 30 pellets of 2g in a carton box (60g)

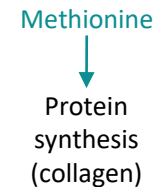
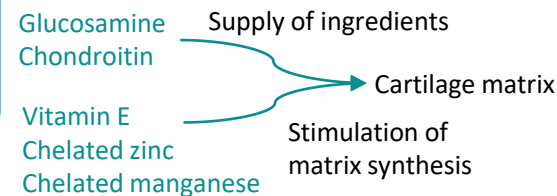


HOW DOES EP RESOLVIN FLEX WORK ?

Inflammation control



Cartilage renewal and quality



HOW TO USE EASYPILL RESOLVIN FLEX ?



- Cut out one of the upper corner of the bag so that the bag can be easily closed again with a clip.
- Give 1 pellet per day
- Duration: 45 days renewable once (3 months supplementation)

WHAT CAN I EXPECT ?

Cats

- Fights pain (better quality of life)
- Increases mobility
- Faster recovery after a joint trauma

Vets

- Management of chronic joint disorders
- After a joint surgery, to limit the use of NSAID
- 2-in-1 product: inflammation control and quality of joint cartilage. Easier to prescribe.

Cats owners

- More dynamic cat
- No need to carry the cat (to climb stairs ...)
- Easy administration, a pleasant moment

INVESTMENT

- 1 box= 1 supplementation for 1 cat for one month.
- Standard supplementation: 3 boxes
